

## SAVE THE HOMOSASSA RIVER ALLIANCE MEETING

1. President Kapocsi called the meeting to order at 7:09 PM
2. Roll call – Board members present were Kapocsi, Rose, Colvin, Runyon, Minguy, and Rimbey. Absent were Rendueles, Green, and Jacobs.
3. Treasurer’s Report – Previous Balance as of 2021-10-30 was \$16,201.87. Current balance as of 2021-11-30 was \$19,967.03.
4. Secretary’s Report – Mr. Kapocsi made a motion that reading of minutes from the 2021-11-18 meeting be waived. Motion passed. The minutes are on HRA's website.
5. Mr. Kapocsi reminded everyone that HRA dues are due January 1.
6. Mr. Kapocsi attended a four hour meeting of the Advisory Committee on the Nature Coast Aquatic Preserve. Prop scarring of the sea grass bed is the primary concern in the Nature Coast Aquatic Preserve.
7. Steve Minguy provided an update on the River Restoration project.
8. Mr. Kapocsi asked Mr. Rimbey to send a letter to FWC expressing HRA's interest in establishing a Springs Protection Zone for the Homosassa River and its contributory spring runs.
9. The upcoming Science Fair is looking for volunteer judges and organizers have reached out to HRA.
10. Mr. Kapocsi introduced guest speaker Detective Josh Doctor with the CCSO. Detective Doctor works the west side of Citrus County. He stated the majority of his time is spent investigating property crimes. Detective Doctor addressed numerous questions from those in attendance.
11. HRA's January 13, 2022 will be organizational so there will be no guest speaker.
